Guidelines and Respectful Practices

All are Welcome - Please respect to Our Lord and others seeking to be with Him

Flame of Love of the Immaculate Heart of Mary devotees have 24-hour access to a Perpetual Vigil Room to spend time with Our Lord! Please feel free to *respectfully* visit Him.

Many like to visit while praying NIGHT VIGILS.

Unlike in a perpetual ADORATION ROOM, in this VIGIL Room, it is not mandatory to remain in complete silence. This is because it is dedicated to public, communal, vocal prayer.

While there, you may pray in silence or join in prayer with others if others are engaged in vocal prayer.

- When entering, enter your name and allow your device microphone and audio access.
- To prevent accidental interruption of prayer, your audio and video are automatically muted when you enter the room. You may unmute if you choose.
- When entering the room, if a cenacle group is in the process of prayer, please join in!
- When entering the room, you will be asked to allow access to your microphone and camera, please allow it; this is just for the room and will NOT allow the entire Internet access.
- Invite intentions from others at appropriate times (for example, between mysteries.) If the room is empty, you may pray as you like.
- When others join, please use known prayers such as the Flame of Love Rosary or other associated prayers.
- If you are leading a prayer and need to depart, please request that someone take your place.
- If there is excessive noise on your line, one of your Prayerful Companions may mute you. To speak, you will need to unmute.
